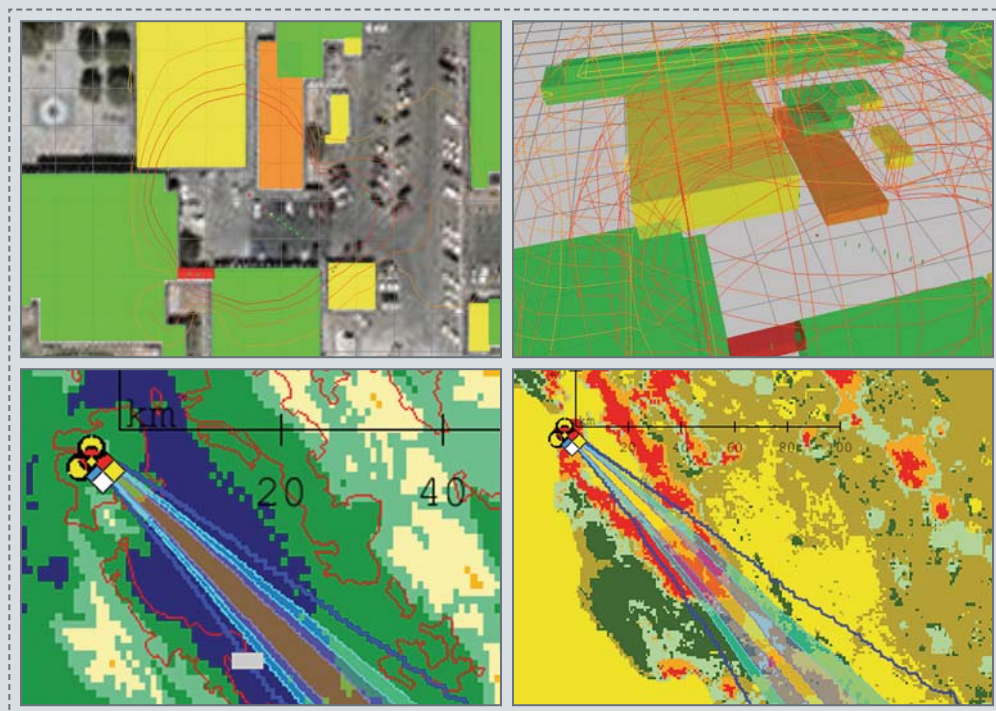

### Vulnerability Assessments | SAFETY Act Certified and Designated

Our assessments identify potential vulnerabilities and effective countermeasures. All components of a chemical facility's physical protection system are reviewed and realistic threats are evaluated. ### Security Surveys | SAFETY Act Certified and Designated

### Red Teams | SAFETY Act Certified and Designated

Red teams identify security risks and develop training to correct identified threats or exposures. This security assessment service pits an adversary team (commonly designated red) against another team (commonly designated blue) in an attempt to simulate acts of aggression against people, physical sites or cyber systems that a blue team is attempting to protect. Table-top analyses and full-participation exercises are included.
