The biggest training issues facing nuclear facilities include keeping up with regulations, maintaining training requirements and shaping course curriculum to stay abreast of updates. Training budget constraints and the ability to build a professional, dedicated employee base with military or law enforcement experience are additional challenges.

Nuclear Training Course Descriptions

Triple Canopy provides a range of training programs for organizations that want to improve security awareness and professionalism. We can develop customized training programs or assist security personnel seeking to maintain professional development skills and certifications.

Lead Controller/Lead Adversary Controller (1 day)

This comprehensive training course prepares controllers in the areas of scheduling and coordinating an adversary team, running an effective force-on-force exercise and preparing a protective strategy brief. From mission statements to complete scenarios, this course teaches students to anticipate regulatory requirements. Students learn scheduling and time management along with force-on-force drill simulations and the effects of explosives and mechanical breaching. Adversary team coordination and team manager expectations are also covered.

Adversary Team (3 days)

This intensive course teaches tactics, close quarter battle (CQB) and explosives handling, including tactical entry and effects. The course utilizes gas, smoke and fragmentation grenades. Developing a mission statement, team management and planning as well as collusion with an insider are all aspects of the class, which is designed to train an adversary team.

Tabletop Exercises (1 day +)

Triple Canopy specializes in the area of preparing and challenging response team leaders with tabletop exercises. Not only will your response team's command and control unit learn from the tabletop exercises, they will be prepared to conduct a flawless exercise.

Close Quarter Battle (5 days)

All facets of CQB operations are covered in this course, including management of live-fire CQB in tactical situations. Safety, surgical shooting, 2-4 person CQB and team CQB operations are addressed.

Tactical Handgun (2 days)

A stair-stepped shooting program, this two-day course covers all the basic skills needed for surgical shooting. Realistic time and accuracy standards are used as a training standard and goal.

Tactical Rifle (2 days)

Students are instructed on the safe management of tactical rifle training for tactical and patrol personnel. Students will shoot from seven to 200 yards with a majority of the training taking place from 100 yards in.

Explosive Ordinance (3 days)

This course exposes operators to the worst-case tactical scenario involving the need to skillfully deal with explosive ordinance or explosive devices.

Explosive Handler (3 days)

This course is designed for users who have no experience in the handling of explosives and will teach skills necessary to safely and effectively manipulate firing devices and charges.

Manual Breaching (2 days)

Tactical employment of manual breaching tools is the focus of this class. The ram, halligan and sledge are the primary tools employed. Window break and rakes are also performed if the targets will support it. Simunitions will be used during this course.

Recapture/Take Back Team (5 days)

This is a stair-stepped tactical training course for operators with first-responder responsibilities. This course will teach operators to safely, quickly and efficiently respond to and neutralize active threats within their installations.

Close Quarter Battle Instructor (6 days)

The safe development and instruction of CQB are the focus of this class. Instructional techniques and tactical plan development will be covered during the course in order to prepare the student to effectively and safely conduct CQB training.

Tactical Handgun Instructor (6 days)

The safe employment of tactical pistol training for tactical, patrol and range personnel is the focus of this class. Students will be able to teach a comprehensive two-day operator course upon completion of this program.

Tactical Rifle Instructor (6 days)

This class instructs students on the safe employment of tactical rifle training for tactical, patrol and range personnel. Students will be able to teach a comprehensive two-day operator course upon completion of the course.

Shoot House Instructor (5 days)

This class instructs students on the safe management of live-fire CQB training for both tactical and range personnel in a standard shooting house.
