SAFETY Act Designated and Certified Services

Triple Canopy’s security assessment services have earned certification and designation by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security as qualified anti-terrorism technologies (QATTs) under the SAFETY Act (Support Anti-terrorism by Fostering Effective Technologies Act of 2002). This legislation promotes the development of effective anti-terrorism products, services and technologies by protecting certified companies and their customers from liability should a terrorist act occur. This protection applies to qualified anti-terrorism technologies and services that are sold to both government and commercial enterprises.

From vulnerability assessments to security surveys to red teams, our security analysis and planning services have met the requirements of the SAFETY Act’s rigorous certification procedure.

Vulnerability Assessments
